

Due to changes external to the EEW Display program you may be seeing a popup dialog when the program is started that says, "The latest release is not available". Replacing the doc.properties configuration file will fix the problem with the program not able to determine if there is an update.

If you are an authorized user, the scenario server was moved to another server last year. Replacing the app.properties configuration file will allow the program to find the new server but note that replacing this file will cause you to lose your custom settings. Before replacing this file, please make note of your preferences such as your home location, default map center, graphics quality and performances, filters and audio settings and other connection settings.

Replacing either of these configuration files is optional and is not required to continue to receive timely alert notifications.

The last version of the program was version 2.8.0 build 20211020. There was a later set of installers that was provided 20230428 that contained an updated code signing certificate required for installation but otherwise it's the same version of the program.

Instructions:

1. Download one or both files.
2. Stop the EEW Display program. Failure to stop the program before replacing the config files could result in the changes getting overridden.
3. Copy the files to the appropriate EEWDisplay data folder depending on your platform.
 - a. On Windows. Use the Windows File Explorer and type %LOCALAPPDATA% into the navigation bar and hit return/enter. Within your LocalAppData folder, you should see a folder called EEWDisplay-2.8.0. Drag the files to this directory.
 - b. On Mac, the default folder will be /Applications/EEWDisplay-2.8.0
 - c. On Unix/Linux, the EEWDisplay-2.8.0 directory could either be on your Desktop or in your home directory.
4. Restart the EEWDisplay program.
5. Upon restart you should no longer get the dialog box that says "The latest release is not available." You can also force a check by using the help Menu pulldown and select "Check for Updates" and it should return with "No update available".

If you ever need to reinstall the program, you will probably want to replace these files again.
